## Christmas Plays and Carol Concert

This year, with the growing number of children in school, we are going to try something a little bit different with regards to Christmas Plays.

Our Reception Class, for the first time, will do their very own performance of the Nativity. This will be followed straight after by the KS1 performance of "I'm going to Shine!". There will be two performances of the Reception and KS1 shows on **Tuesday 10**th of December-the first at **1,45pm** followed by another performance at **5pm**. We ask that before the evening performance (at 5pm, in order for it to run smoothly,) the children go home after school, have something to eat and return to school by 4.30pm at the latest, via the main entrance. On **Wednesday 11**th December, our KS2 children will lead us in a carol service, where the Christmas message will be brought to life through readings, songs and carols. Again, there will be two performances of the Carol Service, one at **1.45pm and the other at 5pm**. We ask that the children return to school by 4.30pm for the 5pm performance via the main entrance.

Each child has an important role to play throughout the performances, so we ask that you make every effort to get the children back to school to make our evening performances successful.
