Weekly Focus: Subtraction

	Activity
Monday	<p>This week we are going to be thinking all about taking away – there are other words that mean the same as ‘take away’ like ...subtract...minus ...count back.</p> <p>When we take away we always count back. Look carefully at this number line:</p>  <p>What is 20 – 2? <i>Did you notice that you counted back?</i></p> <p>Task: Make your own 0-20 number line and then use it to help you work out the answers on this fun train game https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/mental-maths-train Click on the  cart and chose Up to 20 Minus Single-Digit Have fun Year One!</p>
Tuesday	<p>Play this fun post box subtraction game: https://www.topmarks.co.uk/Flash.aspx?f=PostSortingcalculationsv2 Use your number line to help you.</p> <p>Make your 0-20 number line into a 0-30 number line - you just need to add on the extra numbers: 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30.</p> <p>Use your longer number line to answer the following questions: Task: $27 - 5 =$ $15 - 3 =$ $28 - 7 =$ $19 - 6 =$ $30 - 4 =$ (you can do some extra ones if you like!)</p> 
Wednesday	<p>Ask your family to write 5 subtraction questions (up to 30) for you and you write 5 subtraction questions for your family. Can you use your number line to help you find the answers – Good Luck Year One! e.g 28 - 6 = Don't forget to check if your family got the answers correct – you can be the teacher and mark their work- don't forget to draw a star or a smiley face if they get the answers correct!</p>
Thursday	<p>Complete the calculation by seleting the missing numbers from the grid. How many can you complete in 2 minutes? https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/subtraction-grids</p> <p>Click on Two Numbers then try Up to 20 If you find that easy you could try Up to 30 then try even higher!
