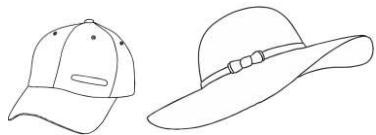


Art/DT

Look at these two beaches (*see resources*)



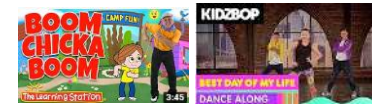
Which beach would you like to go to? Why?

History

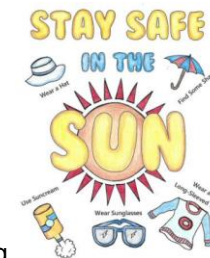
Look at the two beach photos. (*see resources*) One photo was taken a very long time ago and one was taken recently. Can you tell which one was which?
