




How many teddy bears are there in the bed?



There are 5 teddy bears in the bed.



There are 4 teddy bears in the bed and 1 teddy bear has fallen out.

There are 5 teddy bears altogether.

$$4 + 1 = 5$$





There are 3 teddy bears in the bed and 2 teddy bears have fallen out.

There are 5 teddy bears altogether.

$$3 + 2 = 5$$



There are 2 teddy bears in the bed and 3 teddy bears have fallen out.

There are 5 teddy bears altogether.

$$2 + 3 = 5$$



There is 1 teddy bear in the bed and 4 teddy bears have fallen out.

There are 5 teddy bears altogether.

$$1 + 4 = 5$$

Read the number bonds. Can you show the different ways of making 5 using your fingers?

$$5 + 0 = 5$$

$$2 + 3 = 5$$

$$4 + 1 = 5$$

$$1 + 4 = 5$$

$$3 + 2 = 5$$

$$0 + 5 = 5$$
