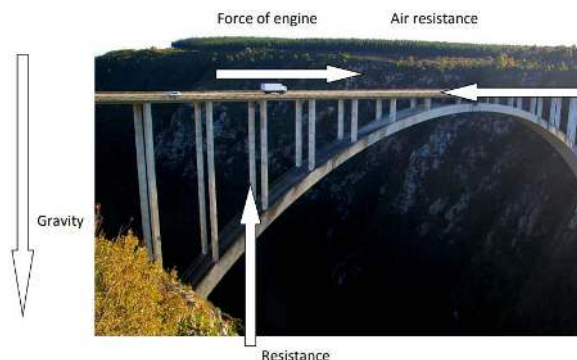
Science
