JESUS CALLS LEVI (based on Luke 5:27-32)

One day Jesus noticed a tax collector called Levi sitting in the tax office. Jesus said to him, “Follow me.”

Levi got up, left everything, and followed Jesus.

Levi gave a party in honour of Jesus. Among the people he invited were a large number of tax collectors and sinners. Some Pharisees and Scribes complained to the disciples, “Why does your master eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?”

Jesus answered them, “Healthy people don’t need a doctor, only sick people do.”



JESUS FEEDS THE PEOPLE (based on Luke 9:12-15)

Jesus had been speaking to the crowds all day. As evening drew near his disciples came to him and said, "Send the people away so that they can go to the nearest villages to find food and shelter for the night, because this is a lonely place."

Jesus said to them, "You give them something to eat."

They answered, "We have only five loaves and two fishes. Are we to go and buy food for all these people?"

There were about five hundred men there. (Luke does not say how many women and children were also there.)

THE WOMEN (based on Luke 8:1-3)

Jesus travelled through towns and villages preaching and proclaiming the Good News. The twelve disciples went with him as well as some **women**. Among them were Mary, whose surname was Magdalene, Joanna whose husband Chuza worked at Herod's court and Susanna. There are many other women who used their own resources to help Jesus and his disciples.
