Wednesday	L.O To plan a story. Recap the story ' The Bog Baby ' by Jeanne Willis & Gwen Millward - YouTube Think about the story and then swap out some of the parts to create your own story. You can use pictures and phrases to help you plan. (see next pages)
Thursday	L.O To write the beginning to a story. Write about how the creature was found and where they went. Remember to check your plan, use conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and a range of punctuation like we have used in class such as ? , . and !. (See Thursday resources on the next pages) Use what I have written to help you with some ideas!
Friday	L.O To write the middle and ending to a story. Children write the middle of their story –where did they take the creature and how did it begin to feel? To write the ending to a story. Write the ending to story and how they released the wild creature back into the wild. Remember to check your plan, use conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and a range of punctuation. 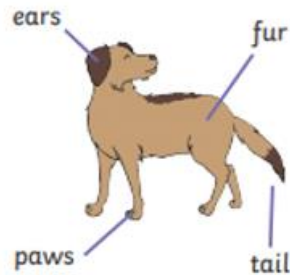
Monday
