Wed	To spell irregular past tense verbs.	<p>Read through these sentences with the irregular verbs in the past tense, can you spot the irregular past tense verbs?</p> <p>When I was in year one the teacher taught me about spelling.  Yesterday I ran really fast!  I saw a huge rain cloud in the sky last night.  My mam said that I must look both ways when crossing the road.  Can you think of any more words you could use in a sentence?  Try to use the following in a sentence!  Taught, said, saw</p>
Thu	To spell irregular past tense verbs.	<p>Practise spelling this weeks common words.  Been, must, hard, am, run, red, bed, air</p> <p>Try and break down some of the difficult irregular verbs by segmenting them and blending them together use words like caught.  Taught, gave, said, drank, fought, learnt, saw  How can we remember words like thought? What memory strategies can we use?  Can you practise spelling the words above see how many you can spell?</p>
