Washing, making, smiling, loving, driving, running, slipping, swimming, writing, sliding  Practice reading them then have a go at using them in a sentence.

Tue	Using the suffix 'ing'	When we add the suffix 'ing' it shows us something has not yet finished it is for example: I am dancing. It doesn't stop!			
		Let's explore the rules when adding the suffix 'ing' to verbs:			
		Rules for Adding '-ing'			
		Short vowel sound, with one consonant – hitting double the consonant and add '-ing'			
		Short vowel sound, with two consonants - add '-ing' jumping			
		Ending in 'e' – drop the 'e' then add '-ing' joking			

Long vowel sound – just add '-ing'

We are going to focus on short vowels, with one consonant so you double the consonant and add '-ing'.
