Tuesday	L.O: To use inverted commas correctly.
	Watch the video to learn about how to use inverted commas: <u>How to use Inverted Commas / Speech Marks - YouTube</u>
	Use the weblink and complete the activities: <u>How to use inverted commas - BBC Bitesize</u>
	Look at the speech inside of the speech bubbles, and write these in a sentence underneath using inverted commas (see resources).
	Remember to tell me who said it (you can choose names for the characters.
	Challenge: Can you write your own sentences using inverted commas?
Wednesday	L.O: To explore the feelings of a character.
	Watch the video clip called 'Tadeo Jones': <u>The Egyptian Pyramids - THE LITERACY SHED</u>
	Create a mind map of different emotions the character may be feeling and think about why. ( See mind map example in resources).
	You may want to use an online thesaurus to up level your vocabulary: Kid Synonyms, Kid Antonyms   Thesaurus.com
	Can you think of 5 questions to ask the character? Don't forget your question mark!
Thursday	L.O: To write a recount using inverted commas.
	Watch the video again from last lesson. Using your work from last lesson, write a recount retelling what is happening in the video. Include
	some direct speech from the character using inverted commas (See resources for example and guidance)
Friday	L.O: To identify the features of a newspaper report.
	Use the weblink to learn about the features of a newspaper report: What are the features of a newspaper? - BBC Bitesize
	Can you match the name of the feature, with the example and the definition? (See resources)
	Can you think of 3 examples of a catchy headline you could use from watching the video?
