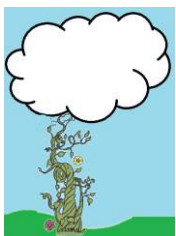


Art/Writing

Last week we labelled the different parts of a plant.

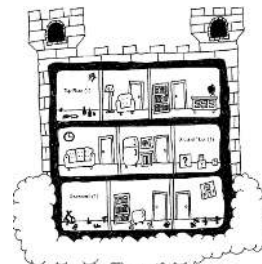
Find out the function of each of these parts. Write and draw what each part does/ why it is important.
