This week we will be exploring the Bible.

The Bible is God's special book that Christians use, because of this we must treat it with respect and always be very careful when we use it. Like all special books we must take care of it and make sure we keep it in a special place.

There are two main sections in the Bible. The Old Testament tells us about life before Jesus. The New Testament tells us about Jesus and the beginning of the church. Some of the books in the Bible are called by the name of the person thought to have written them: Mark, Peter. Some are named after the person the story is about: Job, Ruth, Jonah. One is called after an event: Exodus. Others tell you about the context of the book: Genesis (beginnings), Psalms, Proverbs, Letters. The Bible is like a library of different books.

God put a rainbow in the sky as a promise to never flood the whole earth again.

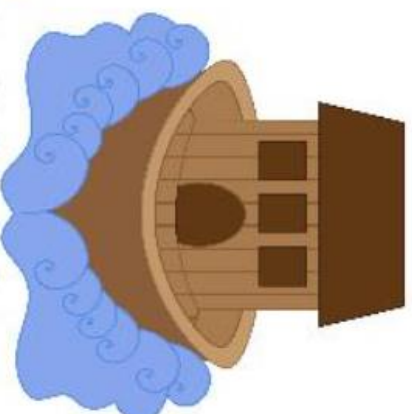


There's going to be a flood.

Noah warned his neighbors about the flood but they didn't believe him.



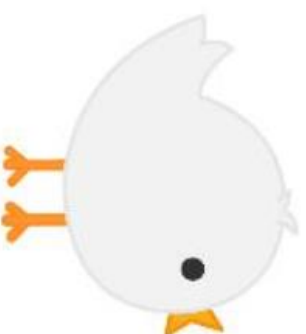
Animals of every kind came to the ark.



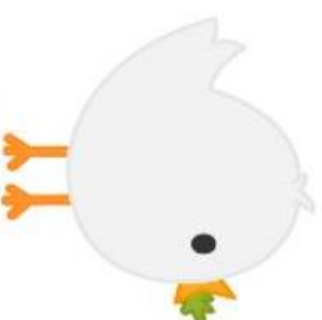
God told Noah to build an ark - a really big boat.
