

In Year 1, we will continue to foster a love for reading – where children want to learn to read for information as well as for enjoyment and pleasure. This






term, we will be reading many stories such as 'Tiger Who Came to Tea' and 'Lost and Found' where the children will be provided with a range of writing opportunities such as, narratives, instructions and letters.

In Geography, we will be learning about where we live. We will be taking a walk in our local area searching for

human and physical features and developing our map skills.

In History, we will be learning about toys through time. This will involve learning about Victorian toys and discussing how they have changed over time.

In Maths, we will be looking at Place Value, before moving on to the operations of addition and subtraction within 10. We will look at how numbers can be represented differently and develop our counting and mental maths skills. We will begin developing our reasoning and problem solving skills through practical tasks. We will look at shape where we will identify and describe 2D and 3D shapes.



In RE, we will be learning about the Holy family and making links to our own families. We will discuss how our families show love towards each other.

Then, we will learn about Baptism and how it is an invitation to belong to God's family.
