This term, we aim to continue to develop your child's independence by introducing more whole class teaching with some aspects of the continuous provision available for the children to use within the classroom.




Your child will receive a reading book and a reading record which will be sent


home on a Friday and to be returned on a Monday.

This term, we will be reading more stories such as 'The

In Geography, we will be learning about the weather. We will be using a world map to locate the line of the Equator and to make connections with hot countries in the world.

In History, we will be continuing our learning about toys through time. This will involve learning about Victorian toys and discussing how they have changed over time.

In Maths, we will be looking at Place Value to 20 and then 50, before moving on to the operations of addition and subtraction. We will look at how numbers can be represented differently and develop our counting and mental maths skills. We will explore length and height, followed by mass and volume. Year 1 will continue to develop their reasoning and problem solving within Math lessons.
