In Science, we will be learning all about living things including the 7 life processes. We will be learning what a habitat is and how different animals adapt to their given habitat. We will be exploring what animals eat, constructing food chains. We will be working scientifically to discover and identify different habitats on our school grounds.



PE will take place on a Monday and Wednesday. Outdoor learning will take place on a Friday. We ask that the children come to school in their PE/ outdoor learning kit which includes their school jumper. We are very lucky this year to have Scout-Ed on a Friday taking our learning outside. During these Friday sessions, we be learning to become more resilient, independent and critical thinkers. Sometimes our learning will be messy, so we ask that your children come to school dressed in suitable warm clothing that you won't mind getting dirty e.g an old tracksuit and wellies. It would be useful if your child could also bring a spare pair of shoes to change into after these sessions (trainers or school shoes). Please can you make sure that all your child's belongings are clearly labelled.



Our topic in PE this term is **multi-skills** where we will be learning to move in a variety of directions with confidence whilst running, jogging, skipping and sprinting. We will also develop a range of jumping and travelling skills.
